INCLUDED IN PRICE: Round Trip Airfare from Calgary, CA, Deluxe Motorcoaches, First Class / Superior First Class Hotels, Guided sightseeing, Entrance fees to sites visited, Breakfast & Dinner daily.

NOT INCLUDED IN PRICE: A total of \$667.95 air taxes comprised of fuel charges of \$279.55 (subject to increase by airline up to 30 days prior to departure) and taxes of \$388.40. These taxes include Federal inspection fees for Customs and Immigrations; international air transportation tax; agricultural tax; other per person taxes imposed by government entities; airport taxes and fees including the September 11th Security fee up to \$10 per person, passenger facility charges up to \$18 per person, federal domestic flight segment fees up to \$3.50 per segment and International arrival and departure, and other government imposed fees up to \$300 per person & Gratuities of \$145 per person for guide, driver & hoteliers, passports; visas (for non-Canadian & US Citizens) and vaccinations; lunches, items of a personal nature; telephone; mini-bar; alcohol, beverages, and food outside of the contracted tour operator menu as presented at a hotel or restaurant (these extra items will be billed to you before leaving the hotel or restaurant); airport transfers on non-qualifying flights; portage at airports; Group Travel Protection premiums; excess baggage fees; and all other items not specifically mentioned.

PAYMENT: A full deposit of USD \$500 per person is required at time of registration. Final payment for trip must be made in the form of a check (credit cards are not accepted for final payment), including optional group insurance premium if applicable, is due no later than **90-days prior to departure**. Thereafter, a late payment fee of \$95 will be assessed. Registrations received after 90-days prior to departure **must be accompanied by full payment**. All tour prices are based on a minimum group size of 20+ passengers for prices to be valid. If group size is less than 15-19 passengers, a \$95 per person supplement to price will apply. *Imagine* reserves the right to add a surcharge if the dollar declines by more than 3% against the shekel based on foreign exchange rates in effect on date when your tour was booked by your tour leader/church.

ACCOMMODATIONS: Price is based on double occupancy. When available, single rooms are often smaller than doubles. While *Imagine* will try to match roommates, we cannot guarantee one will be available. Roommates may be assigned as late as 35 days prior to departure and, if one is not available or if you request a single room, you will be charged for a single room: \$595 for basic itinerary.

ITINERARY and CHANGES: Because airlines often change flight schedules after brochures are printed, *Imagine* reserves the right to shorten or lengthen the itinerary accordingly and, whenever possible, you will be notified in writing. If itinerary changes necessitate extra overnights, you will be charged \$175 per night/per person; single rooms \$215 per night. Meals for extra night are not included. Any changes and/or deviations from the program and/or departure city listed by the passenger must be provided in writing to *Imagine Tours & Travel* no later than 70-days prior to departure. All tours are finalized at 60-days prior to departure and there are no changes or additions to the tour after that time.

AIRLINE TICKETS: In order to keep prices low, *Imagine* does not guarantee the most direct routing to your final destination. Once printed, airline tickets cannot be changed or refunded thereafter. Air transportation to/from your destination will be economy class aboard IATA and ARC carriers utilizing APEX or SUPER APEX non-refundable, non-amendable tickets for groups of 10 or more flying together for entire itinerary. *Imagine* is unable to use individual frequent flyer points to upgrade or accept as partial payment for air transportation.

VISAS: Applicable visas will be obtained by *Imagine* for U.S. and Canadian Citizens only. All passengers who do not carry U.S. or Canadian Passports will be responsible for obtaining visas to the countries they are visiting, *Imagine* is not responsible for non-U.S. & Canadian Passport holders.

FLIGHT TIMES: All flight times are subject to change by the airlines without advance notice. *Imagine* is not responsible for such changes or delays and does not reimburse expenses resulting from such delays. If making your own flight arrangements to a departure city, we recommend you purchase a ticket which can be changed without large penalties. Passengers are responsible for reconfirming their flights with the airline 24 hours prior to departure. *Imagine* does not guarantee you will be on the most direct flights, as flight routings are chosen by the airlines and not *Imagine*.

CANCELLATION FEES: From day of registration to 100 days prior to departure, you will be charged a \$300 non-refundable administration fee plus any airline penalties. Thereafter, you will be charged a single room fee if your cancellation forces your roommate into a single room. The following charges also apply: 99-59 days = \$500; 58-40 days = \$1750; 39-21 days = 75% of total cost; 20 days to day of departure = 100% of total cost. All cancellations must be received in writing. On or after day of departure, no refund for any services not used. We strongly recommend you purchase travel insurance.

DAY 01 – Nov. 6, DEPART FOR TEL AVIV

Tour members depart Calgary, Alberta for our flight to Frankfurt, Germany for Tel Aviv, Israel. We will be served meals accordingly to flight schedule.

DAY 02 – Nov. 7, ARRIVE TEL AVIV, ISRAEL

We arrive in Frankfurt, where we change planes for our connecting flight onto Tel Aviv, Israel. We arrive in Israel late afternoon. Upon arrival we are met by our agent who assists us through customs and security. We are then transferred to our motor coach for our drive to the Dead Sea, Ein Bokek Area. We drive through the Judean Wilderness with a descent of approximately of almost 3000+ feet, to what is often referred to as the lowest spot on earth. Welcome dinner and overnight at our Dead Sea re-sort Le Meridian Hotel or similar.

DAY 03 - Nov. 8 DEAD SEA, MASADA, EIN GEDI, QUMRAN, GIDEON SPRINGS, GALILEE

After a refreshing swim, enjoy a relaxing breakfast before we start our days sightseeing. Our first stop will be a visit to Masada, where we will ascend high upon the wilderness mountain by way of cable car to the fortress build by King Herod. Here we will survey the ruins of the fortifications, waterworks, synagogue, temples and palaces.

After a quick snack and drink, it is a short drive to Ein Gedi, where David hid from King Saul. It is here we will hike the rocky path to one of the beautiful spots in the region. Once we have finished lunch at Ein Gedi we follow the road along north along the Dead Sea we travel to Qumran, where the Dead Sea Scrolls were discovered. There will be opportunity to see the cave where the Dead Sea Scrolls were found. From there we make our way to the Galilee, with our last sightseeing stop at Gideon Springs (Judges 7) there is a famous account where Gideon brought the army of Israel to this spring to select warriors who would join him in battle. We will have dinner and spend that night in Tiberias at the Ramot Resort Galilee or similar, overlooking the Sea of Galilee.

DAY 04– Nov. 9, GALILEE, JESUS BOAT, BOAT RIDE ON SEA OF GALILEE, CAPERNAUM, MT. OF BEATITUDES

There is nothing quite like watching a sunrise on the Sea of Galilee from your hotel. We begin our day with

a boat ride on the Sea of Galilee and then a special visit to the 2000-year-old replica Jesus Boat that dates back to the time of Christ. Today will include many biblical sites along the shore of the Sea of Galilee which includes Capernaum (Matt. 4:13) and Mount of Beatitudes (Matt. 5-7). Dinner and then enjoy the sunset with worship in Tiberias.

DAY 05 – Nov. 10, CAESAREA PHI-LIPPI, GOLAN HEIGHTS AND DAN

After breakfast we begin our travels to view Mt. Hermon (Deut. 3:8), and Hazor (Josh 11:10; 1 Kgs. 9:15) make a short drive to the Golan Heights area to see the Good Fence, and we can view Lebanon from a distance. We then will drive north to Caesarea Philippi (Baniyas; Mark 8:27) where we will have an opportunity to see the location where Jesus spoke to his disciples and asked them who do you say that I am? We will then continue on to Tel Dan and then return back to our hotel in the Galilee for dinner and overnight.

DAY 06 – Nov. 11, NAZARETH, MEGIDDO, MT. CARMEL, JERUSALEM

Today we depart for Galilee, visiting the following biblical sites: Nazareth—visit the Synagogue Church (Luke 1 & 2), then on to Megiddo (Armageddon; 1 Kgs. 9:15; Rev. 16:16) - we'll stop at Druze Village in time for lunch and shopping, then it will be onto Mt. Carmel (1 Kgs. 18). Then it will be onto Jerusalem for Dinner and over-night at the Crowne Plaza Hotel or similar.

DAY 07 – Nov. 12, MT. OF OLIVES, GARDEN OF GETHSEMANE, TEMPLE MOUNT, VIA DOLOROSA, RABBINICAL TUNNEL

We begin our explorations with a drive to the beautiful Mt. of Olives to behold the breath-taking panorama of the Holy City. Our pilgrimage will proceed to Dominus Flevit, then onto Gethsemane with its ancient olive grove, and there visit the Church of Agony, where tradition holds that Jesus prayed. We will enter Jerusalem through the Dung Gate, and walk to the holiest site in the whole Jewish world, the Western Wall (Wailing Wall) of Herod's temple. Beyond the wall lies the 35-acre temple area purchased by King David (2 Sam. 24:18-25).

On this site now stands the Dome of the Rock (the third holiest shrine in all Islam) and views the El-Aksa Mosque. From the temple area, we make our way to the Rabbinical Tunnel and then St. Anne's Crusader Church, Pools of Bethesda, the Sister of Zion Convent (to see the Pavement where Jesus stood as he was being tried by Pilate), Ecco Homo Arch, and then follow the Via Dolorosa a short visit to the Church of the Holy Sepulchre and the ancient Cardo. Dinner and overnight in Jerusalem.

DAY 08 – Nov. 13, DAVIDSON CENTER, SOUTHER STEPS, CITY OF DAVID, YAD VASHEM, GARDEN TOMB

We begin the day with a special visit to the new Davidson Center and Southern Steps (the actual steps that Jesus would have walked up to the Temple Mount). Then we will go to recently excavated City of David visit, afterwards we drive to St. Peter Gallicantu. From there we will go to Yad Vashem Holocaust Memorial and will have lunch. Late in the afternoon we will visit

the Garden Tomb for a special Communion Service. Dinner and overnight in Jerusalem.

DAY 09 – Nov. 14, JERUSALEM, DAY WITHOUT PLANNED ACTIVITIES

Today is without a planned program with the exception of doing Bethlehem first thing in the morning. From there you will have time to explore Jerusalem on your own or revisit the places of most interest: Hezekiah's Tunnel, Jerusalem ramparts, Israel Museum & the Shrine of the Book where the Dead Sea Scrolls are displayed, Herodian. Your tour guide will be able to provide you with some suggestions on arrangements for you to explore and visit these sites on your own. Dinner and overnight in Jerusalem.

DAY 10—Nov. 15, YAD HASHMONA, CAESAREA MARITIMA, TEL AVIV

After a leisure breakfast we begin our day of sightseeing with a visit to Yad Hashmona for a visit to the Biblical Village with a detailed explanation. Afterwards we begin our drive towards the west coast of Israel for the Mediterranean Sea. We arrive-rive at Caesarea Maritima (Acts 9 & 25), where we will have ample time to see this incredible excavated city, aqueducts, theatre and much more. Dinner and overnight in Tel Aviv area at Maccabia Hotel.

DAY 11 – Nov. 16, TEL AVIV, USA

Morning transfer to Ben Gurion Airport for our return flight back home. We arrive back in Alberta, Canada the same day.
